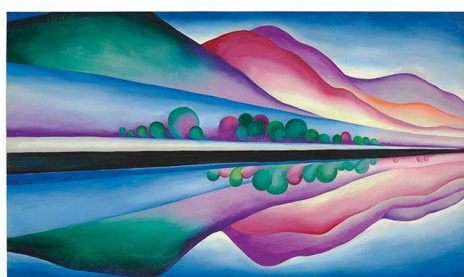


## Ryman Vouchers for Teachers

## Nursery and 30hrs (Frida Kahlo) and Reception (Georgia O'Keeffe)



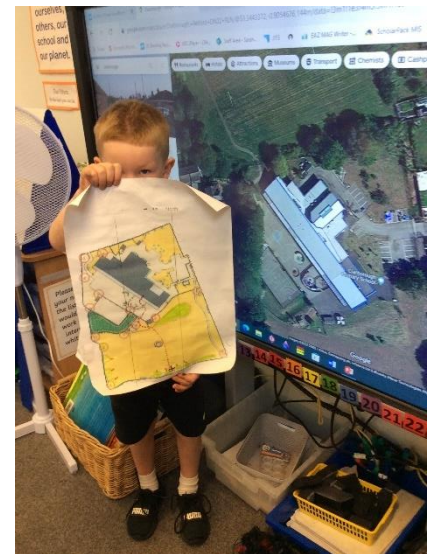

Everyone in the Foundation Stage team would like to say a HUGE well done to the children for all their hard work this year - their brains have grown so much!

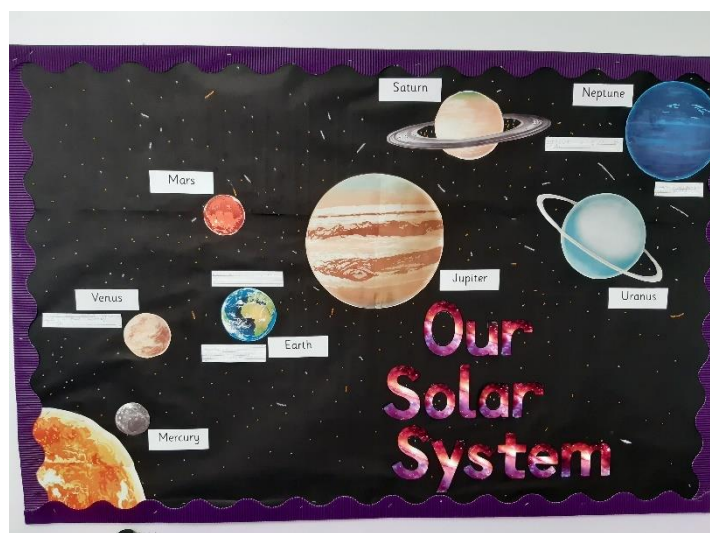

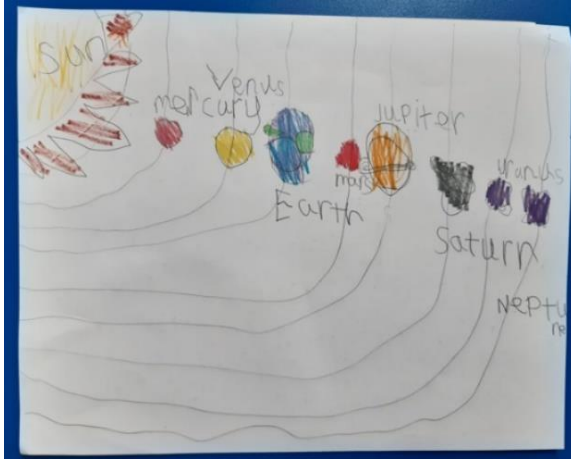


## Year 1 (Joan Miro)

In Art, the children have been painting sunflowers to create a new display for the hall. They have also been working on teamwork and reading feelings and enjoyed keeping cool in the hot weather.



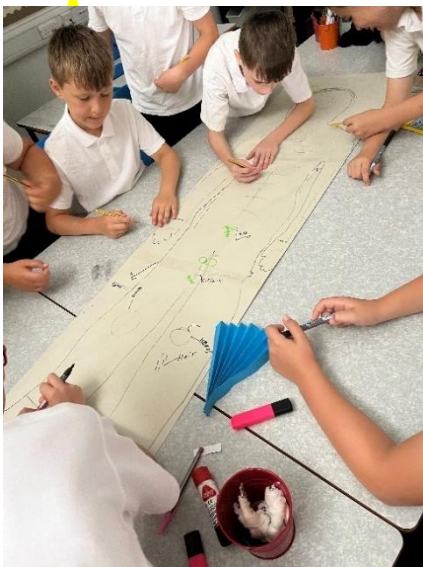
